# SOLEMN EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT: FOR OUR LINKED PARISHES

- St Cuthbert's will take up the Solemn Exposition on Monday (7<sup>th</sup> October) beginning immediately after 12 noon Mass until Benediction that day at 6.00pm. On Tuesday (8<sup>th</sup> October) Exposition at St Cuthbert's will resume immediately after the usual 10.00am Mass concluding with Solemn Benediction at 7.00pm.
